Children 2 and under: Free

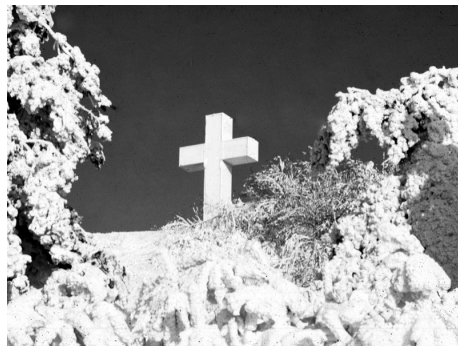
SATURDAY ONLY : \$15.00 (3yrs thru adult)
